All of the people had similar concerns and Jill and Peter realized that they have something very special to offer. They decided to form an alliance that would help educators, political operatives, parents, & CEO's to understand & address the crisis of an undereducated society that lacks common goals. Then the Massacre happened in Parkland, Florida. In Jill's neighborhood - in the same high school her daughter graduated from. A neighbor & dear friend's son was massacred - along with 16 others with 17 students taken to hospitals - by an ex-student with a high powered gun of war. It became clear to both Jill and Peter that they had to provide their knowledge and skills to provide balance, empathy and ways to self-heal to the community.
